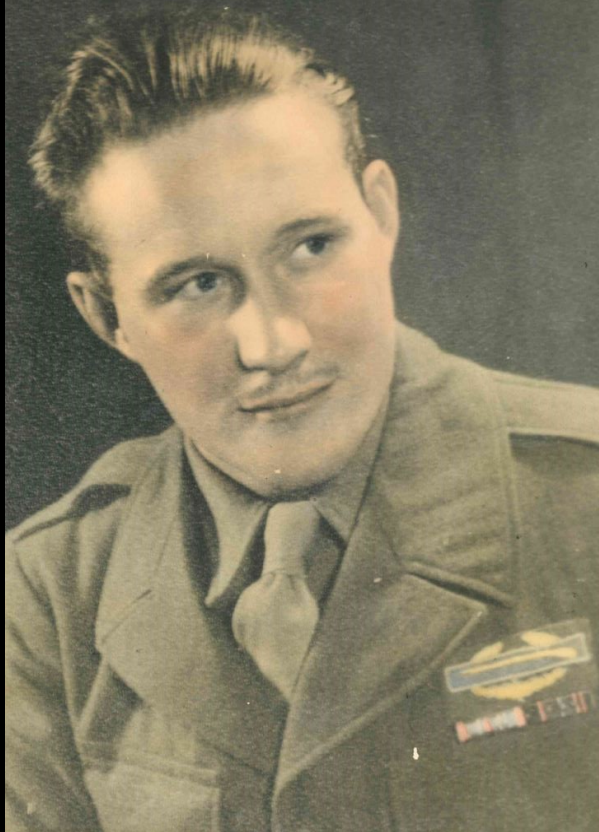


GEORGE W GRAHAM JR
